**1. Opening and welcome** – Mohammed-Ali Daderker welcomed members and opened the meeting at 3.41pm

**2. President's Report** – Mohammed-Ali Daderker

- Our second season in the new club rooms, my first as president – we focussed on re-establishing the energy and passion across the club.
- On the field:
  - We boasted 276 members with 79 seniors, 102 in the juniors & 95 in the Blasters Program.
  - This translated to five senior teams, 10 junior boys' teams as well Master and Junior Blaster competition.
  - Continued success for all the junior teams – evident by two teams making finals and our u14's team getting to the grand final.
  - Building on our strengths as single junior and senior club – evidenced by the number of juniors who play games in the senior sides this year.
- The committee has been focused on the off-field operations.
  - Canteen established for junior home games.
  - Purchase of table tennis which encouraged members to get back after games particularly from a senior's side. We even held table tennis tournaments during the season.
- We've continued to hold our annual events.
  - Juniors – Xmas function and Trophy day and weekly Award vouchers.
  - Seniors – Glascott Game, Kenny's Round and Wind Up.
  - Whole – Quiz night, Country week and Golf Day.
- Long term sponsors locked in again for next season.
- This scale means that we continue to present as an affordable, sustainable Club with a strong future.

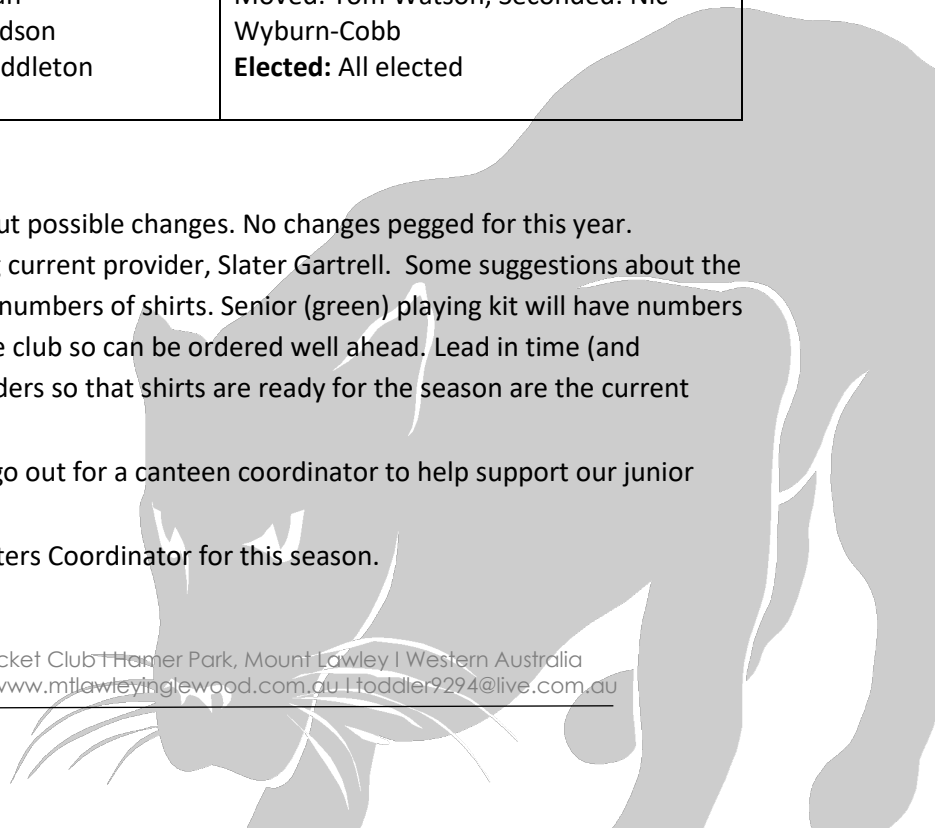
- Profit (less expenses \$74 532.09): \$12 466.55 (as of 30 June 2024)
